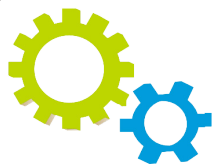

Should your TIL equipment ever need changing, updating, or servicing, a TIL technician will work with you to make your system work as soon as possible.

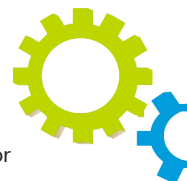
Can I afford TIL services?
